

ATHLETES COMPETING IN THE AQUATIC CENTER

Face masks are always required when athletes are not competing.

All athletes competing in the Aquatic Center events will enter the Aquatic Center via the Freedom Pool near the diving tower. Athletes will receive their health screening and temperature checks upon entering the Freedom Pool area.

All athletes will find seating on the bleachers in a designated spot – they are marked on the bleachers. Athletes are to remain in their designated location when they are not competing.

There will be assigned warm up lanes for all athletes.

Athletes must report to the bullpen staging area near the diving tower no earlier than three heats prior to their race. All athletes will enter the bulkhead from the spectator bleacher side of the pool. All athletes will exit the bulkhead from the windows side of the bulkhead.

There is to be no changing or utilizing of locker rooms by the athletes, all athletes should utilize Freedom Pool restrooms. All athletes are expected to arrive and depart in their bathing suits. All athletes will depart from the Aquatic Center via the Freedom Pool.

Again, face masks are required at all times that the athletes are not competing. Social distancing will be enforced and any athlete not complying will be removed from the meet.

COACHES IN THE AQUATIC CENTER

Face masks are always required when inside the Aquatic Center.

Coaches must head to the check-in location to receive their health screenings immediately upon arrival. All coaches will access the Aquatic Center via the Freedom Pool. All coaches will need to be valid USA Swimming coaches. All coaches will depart from the Aquatic Center via the Freedom Pool.

VOLUNTEERS IN THE AQUATIC CENTER

Face masks are always required when inside the Aquatic Center.

Volunteers must head to the check-in location to receive their health screenings immediately upon arrival. All volunteers will access the Aquatic Center via the Freedom Pool. Volunteers should head to the computer table to await further instructions from the volunteer coordinator. All volunteers will depart from the Aquatic Center via the Freedom Pool.

OFFICIALS IN THE AQUATIC CENTER

Face masks are always required when inside the Aquatic Center.

Officials must head to the check-in location to receive their health screenings immediately upon arrival. All officials will access the Aquatic Center via the Freedom Pool. Officials must head directly to the computer table for their meeting with the meet referee. All officials will depart from the Aquatic Center via the Freedom Pool.

SPECTATORS IN THE AQUATIC CENTER

Face masks are always required when inside the Aquatic Center.

Spectators will utilize the upper level entrance of the Aquatic Center for their health screening. Spectators must practice social distancing when in the spectator area.

All athletes, officials, coaches, volunteers, and spectators must promptly exit the facility upon completion of the session or when their athlete has finished competing.

While sessions of the meet are taking place in the Freedom Pool as well, no athlete, coach, official, or spectator should be entering the Freedom Pool area if their athlete or assignment is for the Aquatic Center events, unless utilizing the Freedom Pool bathroom facilities.

COVID Check-in times for **ATHLETES AND COACHES** are as follows; once the gate is closed there is no entry. Please do not come more than 5 minutes prior to your scheduled check-in time. The Parking Circle is for drop off and pick-up only, No loitering. All sessions are staggered to allow for social distancing.
