FORMAT: The meet is timed finals format.

This meet will be Pre-Seeded; NO SCRATCHES, NO CHANGES will be permitted at the table.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. "Deck

Registrations" will NOT be accepted

Age on October 9th, 2021 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special consideration. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee

of any disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: Swimmers may be entered in a maximum of 3 individual events per session.

All entries must be in yards. Deck entries will not be accepted.

NT's will not be accepted. NTs will be REJECTED.

DEADLINE:

- 1: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams entries must be received by October 4, 2019.
- 2: The final entry deadline for this meet is October 2, 2021.
- 3. Each team will be allowed to enter up to 10 swimmers per age group.

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

An entry fee of \$7.00 per individual event must accompany the entries. A Facility Surcharge of \$7.50 per swimmer must accompany the entries.

WARM-UP: First 30 minutes will be general warm-up. Lane assignments will be given at meet. Last 10 minutes:

2 or more lanes will be open for one-way sprint. All other lanes will remain open for general warm-

up.

SCRATCHES: This meet will be PRE-SEEDED. No scratches/changes will be permitted on the day of the meet.

Deck changes are prohibited. DECK

CHANGING:

In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, **COACHES** valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet.

Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area
