ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited SSC-MR USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers. All

swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. No Deck

Age on June 13, 2024 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$8.00 per individual event must accompany the entries.

An athlete surcharge of 10.00 per swimmer must accompany the entries.

Payment must be received by **June 13**, **2024** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact the Meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish

considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

WARM-UP: General warm up with assigned lanes for the first 55 minutes. Starts are during your warmup.

scratch sheet for each session.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later

than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual

event scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current,

valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet.

Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.
